Regatta Announcement

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

The organizing authority is Veloclub Palermo - www.velaclubpalermo.it - info@velaclubpalermo.it - on behalf of the Italian Sailing Federation.

2. LOCALITY AND PROGRAM OF THE RACE:

The event will take place in the Gulf of Mondello with the following schedule:

- 30th March - 10.00 am coach meeting
- Regattas; warning signal 1st test 11.25 hours
- March 31-- Regattas
- April 1st - Regattas
- 2nd April-- Regattas and awards

For the time of departure of the tests of the days to follow the first will be issued a statement by 20.00 the day before. In the absence of press releases, the time of the previous day will be confirmed.

The Race Committee may modify the program in case of adverse weather conditions or for any other circumstances.

12 tests will be possible, with a maximum of 3 tests per day. If a minimum of 6 tests have been completed, in the following days the competitors will be divided into two fleets, a "gold" and a "silver". Otherwise you will continue with the battery mode.

Only one scrap will be used, which will apply from the fourth test.

No warning signal will be displayed after 3.30pm on 2nd April.

3. REGULATIONS:

The race will be disputed by applying the Rules as defined in the W.S. Regulation. (World Sailing) in force; the FIV Regulations for Sport Activities 2018, including the FIV regulations that must be understood as "Rule"; the present Call, the I.d.R. and official announcements that will be exhibited on the Official Notice Board. In case of contrast between these will prevail the I.d.R. and subsequent official announcements (Mod. RRS 63.7). The "P" appendix of the RRS will be applied (immediate penalties for rule 42).

The notation '[DP]' in a rule of the Notice of Race means that the penalty for infraction of a rule may be, at the discretion of the protest committee, less than a disqualification.

4. ADVERTISING:

The Regatta is classified as "free sponsorship". The Organizing Club may request the boats to display a sticker representing the name of the Event Sponsor on both sides of the hull, which must be displayed for the entire duration of the event, in accordance with Regulation 20.4 W.S. The stickers will be provided by the Organizing Circle. Boats displaying individual advertising must be in possession of the FIV license for valid advertising.

5. ADMISSION:

Class 420 boats whose crews are FIV and UNIQUA ITALIA members are eligible to participate. The regatta is valid for the national ranking list. Foreign crews may participate as long as they comply with the requirements of the National Authority they belong to.

6. REGISTRATION:

Registration must be made by downloading the form from the site www.saillab.net and sending it to info@velaclubpalermo.it, anticipating the documents and the bank transfer with the registration.

The registration fee must be paid by bank transfer to the Velaclub Palermo - causal: registration 420 number of sail –

Registration must be completed by March 29 with the presentation of:

- copy fee registration fee;
- measurement certificate;
- FIV 2018 card with valid medical examination of type B
- The certification of the UNIQUA association;
- R.C. insurance with minimum coverage as per FIV Regulations
- advertising license if it occurs.
- Minor contestants must present the foster form.

The registration fee is set at € 100.00.

Minor contestants will have to deliver the enrollment form signed by the parent, guardian or "Support Person" who consent to comply with the Rules (RRS 3.1 (b)) and who, during the event, assumes the responsibility to make it fall in the water to race.

7. MEMBERING

All competitors must be in compliance with the FIV and UNIQUA membership for the current year and in particular for the type B (competitive) medical examination as per the Regulations.

8. OBLIGATIONS OF STAY

All boats must have a valid measurement or conformity certificate, which must be delivered to the Secretariat upon completion of registration.

The competitors will have to compete with boats, sails and equipment regularly measured and can not replace the sail or other equipment without authorization.

All boats must race with the sail number shown on the measurement certificate. Any changes may be authorized by the Technical Committee or, if it has not been appointed by the C.d.R., only for breakage or damage after verification of the damage by the Technical Committee or the C.d.R.

9. INSURANCE

Each boat must have adequate insurance coverage, as per Federal Regulations in force. A copy of the policy must be presented upon completion of the registration.

10. RACING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available to the members at the time of completion of the registration.

11. ROUTES

The routes will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

12. SCORING SYSTEM

As per RRS 90.3 and relative Appendix A.

13. AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded:

- to the first three classified as absolute
- to the first junior crew
- to the first junior female crew
- to the first crew under 17
- to the first female crew under 17
- to the first foreign crew
- to the first foreign female crew

14. SUPPORT PERSONNEL BOATS

All support persons must register by completing the registration form available at the Regatta Secretariat stating:

- 1) the characteristics of your vehicle;
- 2) the acceptance of the "Rules for Support Staff Boats" described in the Sailing Instructions;
- 3) the names of the accompanying Competitors.

The accredited Supporting Persons will be subject to the technical and disciplinary guidelines of the C.d.R and the Jury which, in the event of an infringement, may act according to rule 64.4.

15. RESPONSIBILITIES

The Organizing Committee, the Race Committee, the Technical Committee where present and the Jury and those who for any reason take part in the organization decline any and all responsibility for damages that may be suffered by persons and / or things, both on land and in water. as a result of their participation in the regatta referred to in this Notice of Race. Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk and under their personal responsibility or those who exercise their responsibilities. Each competitor will be solely responsible for the decision to participate in the regatta, to continue it or to renounce it.

16. PHOTOGRAPHIC AND / OR TELEVISION RIGHTS

The Competitors grant full right and permission to the Organizer to publish and / or transmit through any media, every photograph or video footage of people or boats during the event, including but not limited to, television commercials and everything that can be used for their editorial or advertising purposes or for printed information
